- ✓ References
- ✓ Payment

Prepare for the examination and pass the examination



## CACM Examination

- 1-Year eligibility to pass the exam
- 3 attempts to pass
- 45 day waiting period between attempts
- Computer based examination:
  - ✓ 3-hour time limit to complete
  - ✓ 150 multiple choice questions
- Secure testing locations worldwide
- Live Remote Proctoring (LRP)



# Maintaining the CACM

- Recertification required every 3 years.
- Required 20 Points
  - ✓ Involvement in the profession
  - ✓ Professional development
  - ✓ A minimum of 1 point must be related to ethics and safety
- All activities can be added to an online recertification management tool for CACMs.





# Determining RIC

1. Was the CM empowered to make a direct impact on the successful project completion?
2. Was the CM directly in charge of construction management services?
3. Did the CM protect the project and the owner's best interests?





## CCM Examination


# Maintaining the CCM
